Breakout Session
Lesson Plan
Sept 17
Fall UELMA**

1. Give students handout. “How much do you know about information literacy?”
2. Discuss each topic and distinguish how much the students know about the internet.
3. Divide into 4 groups with at least 4 students in each group.
4. Explain the criteria for evaluating a website and evaluate one together. Example: www.dhmo.org or www.home.inreach.com/kumbach/velcro.html
5. Give each group a Topic with websites page.
6. Give each student within the group a specialist evaluation assignment.
7. Assign a group leader at each table.
8. Allow the students 20-30 minutes to accomplish the task.
9. Give each group a chance to report to the class on their site rankings or on why their #1 pick was their favorite.
10. It helps at this point if the teacher will give them an assignment where they can use their newly found skills.
